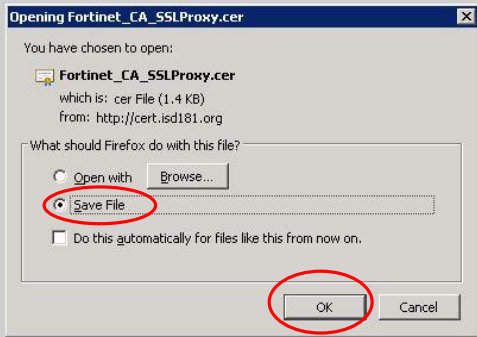

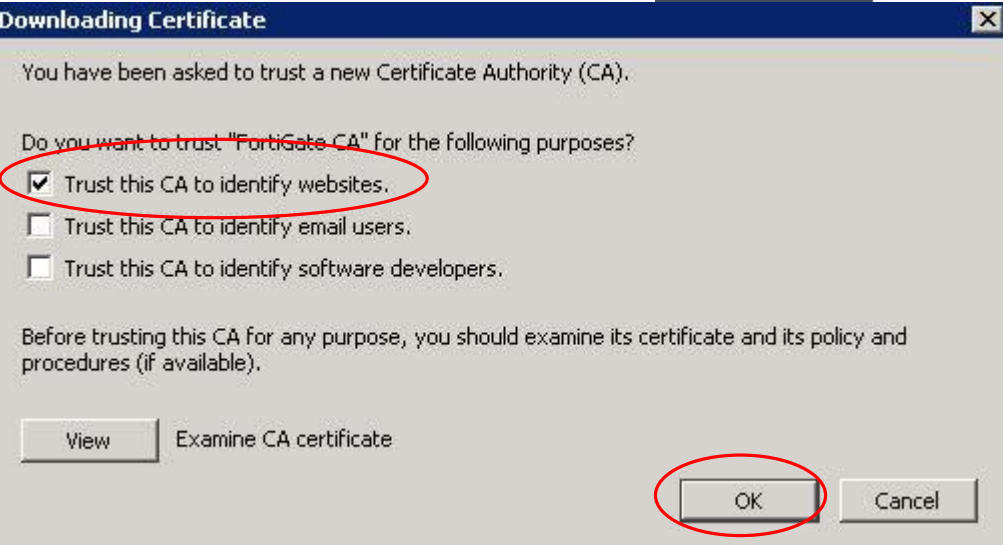
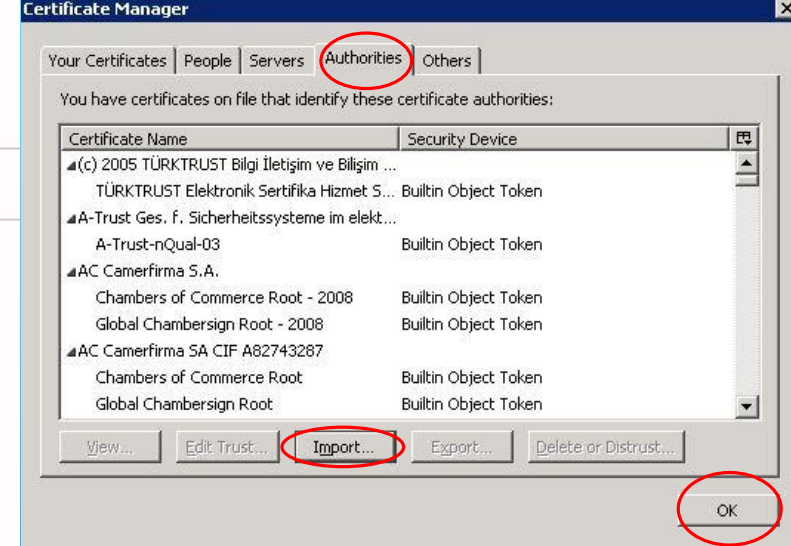

Requests

When a server requests my personal certificate:

- Select one automatically
- Ask me every time
- Query OCSP responder servers to confirm the current validity of certificates



1. Download Certificate file and save it.
2. Go to "Options" in Firefox and "Advanced".
3. Select "Certificates".
4. Select "View Certificates".
5. Select "Import".
6. Browse to the location where you saved the certificate file and select it.
7. Check only the box "Trust this CA to identify websites." and then select "OK" to import and trust the certificate.

- ▶ Your Firefox browser now trusts the ISD181 certificate and you will no longer see any invalid certificate warnings when visiting SSL enabled websites.
